LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) is an internationally recognized green building certification that measures efficiency in green design and construction. LEED recognizes achievements in areas such as water efficiency, energy efficiency and sustainable building materials. ## Roles and Responsibilities

LEED consultants advise on all aspects of a building's LEED certification process. As a LEED Consultant, you work alongside sustainable architects or are hired by homeowners or organizations to ensure that the architects and contractors are making good on their green promises. You will make recommendations and assist with the design and implementation of LEED principles. At times, you may make presentations on LEED certification or perform a LEED rating analysis on a building. You will also be responsible for preparing the necessary paperwork for certification.
